



Visa and Health Insurance

Visa

It is the student's responsibility to obtain a correct type of visa to participate in Soongsil International Summer School. As each country has different policies in visa management, please consult the Korean Embassy or Korean Consulate Office in your country for the proper visa type.

In general, students from a country or region where Korea has a visa-waiver agreement may participate in Soongsil International Summer School with the K-ETA (Korea Electronic Travel Authorization). You may check your eligibility by visiting the K-ETA website (www.k-eta.go.kr, <http://asq.kr/xPpkI9Y4P2>).

Students from countries which are excluded from the visa-waiver agreement program must apply for a [short-term study visa \(D-2-8\)](#) or a [tourist visa \(C-3-9\)](#) at the Korean Embassy or Korean Consulate Office [in the country you are currently studying at](#). Obtaining a visa may be time-consuming and therefore we encourage students to start preparing for it as early as possible.

The following is a general list required documents for issuing a short-term study visa (D-2-8).

Required Documents

- Visa Application Form (www.hikorea.go.kr)
- Passport
- Certificate of Admission (This will be issued by Soongsil University via email.)
- Certificate of Business Registration of Soongsil (This will be issued by Soongsil University via email.)
- Financial affidavit form and proof documents
(A bank statement or a scholarship certificate proving that you maintain a minimum balance or have a scholarship certificate to receive a visa)
- Color photos
- Visa processing fee
- Other documents required by the Korean consulate

Health Insurance

All students must have international health insurance that covers possible injury and medical treatment during the program. Proof of Insurance must be submitted [up to 4 weeks before the start of the program on the application website](#). The document should include information as follows:

- Name of the insured
- Period of coverage
- Place of coverage

Failure to provide the document will result in termination of participation/enrollment in our program.

To and From Incheon International Airport

- Go to the Exit 6B/13A on the 1st Floor → Take the Bus No. 6019 → Get off at the Soongsil Univ. Annex




