Program overview

Graduates of the program are logistics specialists, who are nevertheless equipped with interdisciplinary knowledge, lean and project management skills as well as information technology know-how.

Our graduates take up careers in international businesses, with forwarders, manufacturers and suppliers, and anywhere else where managing the flow of materials, analyzing outbound and inbound processes and skilled team management is needed. The B.Sc. degree also gives you the option of pursuing a Master's degree in Supply Chain Management/ Logistics to further expand and deepen your knowledge.

Program structure

The curriculum includes seminars, lectures, field trips as well as project work and practical experience. The basics modules in the first four semesters will give you a strong foundation in core disciplines a well-versed logistics manager has to master: economics, accounting, procurement, production, distribution, project management and foreign languages. The advanced study modules will give you an opportunity to enrich your study experience by different perspectives: lean management, ERP systems, logistics lab, operations research and transportation law.

Modules for international and exchange students

As an international student you can choose to study the full B.Sc. Logistics Management program or spend one or two semesters as an exchange student with us. As an exchange student you can select different English-taught business modules from the B.Sc. Logistics Management program or any other B.Sc. program in the winter and the summer term. Also, we are offering intensive German language modules (4 credits), semester-long German modules (2.5 credits) for all levels as well as interdisciplinary modules i.e. Engineering Ethics, Digital Emotions, European Identities for all international students (2.5 credits) during the winter and summer semester.

The Logistics Management degree program is subject to limited admission (NC).

- Subject-specific higher education entrance qualification valid in Hessen
- Entrance qualification for a university of applied sciences valid in Hessen
